


SPRINTER VAN LOW PRO FRONT FAIRING - HIGH ROOF SP0111B




+ 5/32" ALLEN WRENCH
+ 3/16" ALLEN WRENCH


STEP | 01 FAIRING ASSEMBLY

1.1 Prepare Crossbar: if you have already installed your low pro roof rack, remove the front crossbar from the rack before beginning.

1.2 Fairing Assembly: Insert the hardware as shown in **FIG 1** into the available slots in the fairing. You'll only want to screw the t-nuts on a little in order to provide clearance for the next step.

1.3 Gasket Install: Attach the **Fairing Gasket** to the **Fairing** in the orientation as shown in **FIG 2.** Firmly press on the **Gasket** with your hand or a mallet until it "seats" itself into place along the front edge of the **Fairing.**







TOOLS REQUIRED FOR THIS STEP: + 5/32" ALLEN WRENCH + 3/16" ALLEN WRENCH

STEP | 02 FAIRING INSTALL

2.1 Crossbar Install: Now, slide the crossbar onto the fairing. You'll have to straighten each t-nut as you go to get it to feed into the crossbar correctly (FIG 3). After sliding the fairing and crossbar together, tighten all five (5) of the 1/4-20" Button Head Screws.

2.2 Fairing Install: Now you're ready to attach the fairing to the roof rack. Slide it in from the front and into the location shown in FIG 4 and tighten down using (2) 1/4-20" Flange Head Screws.





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
