

STEP | 01 LAYOUT AND INSTALL PREP

1.1 Removing Factory Bolts: The first step is to remove the factory bolts on the step portion of your bumper (FIG 1). If there are plastic caps installed, use a Flathead Screwdriver to remove them. The bolts themselves require a T45 Bit for removal.

1.2 Removing European Style License Plate Cover (If Applicable): Some vans come equipped with a European style license plate cover (FIG 2) as opposed to the US-Style Plate Mount (FIG 3), which needs to be removed. Note that while some mount the nudge bar without removing the Euro style plate mount, it can interfere with park sensors if your vehicle is equipped with them.









TOOLS REQUIRED FOR THIS STEP:

+ T45 TORX KEY + RATCHFT

13MM WRENCH OR SOCKET

+ LOCTITE

STEP | 02 NUDGE BAR INSTALL

2.1 Attaching the Nudge Bar: Place the Nudge Bar on the front step area **(FIG 4)**, aligning the mounting slots, and thread in the hardware provided with Loctite. The large washer should go underneath the head of the **M8 Bolt**. Finger-tighten the bolts.

NOTE - This is a two-handed operation. It's best to hold the nudge bar down with one hand on the front tube by the mounting bracket and use your other hand to thread the bolts in **[FIG 5]**.

2.2 Securing the Nudge Bar: Hold the nudge bar tight against the bumper, ensuring it is centered, then tighten the hardware.

Note for Vans with Camera Packages: If your van is equipped with the front view or 360 camera packages, be aware of potential changes in your front view camera's perspective after installing the nudge bar (FIG 6).
